Healthcare employees must complete this training once every three years if:

- They are transporting hazmat in commerce (generally does not apply to healthcare employees).
- Causing hazmat to be transported or shipped in commerce. In other words, you are a staff person who is packaging waste for transport, such as any employee who is responsible for tying off infectious waste bags, inspecting hazardous waste storage areas, or packaging hazardous waste shipments.
- Representing, marking, certifying, selling, offering, reconditioning, testing, repairing, or modifying packaging as qualified for use in the transportation of hazmat. In other words, you are a staff person who signs waste manifests for infectious or hazardous waste shipments.
