INCENTIVE

An energy assessment was recently performed for Pearson's, identifying many energy

saving opportunities, and offering Xcel Energy rebates plus additional Turn Key Incentives for many of the projects if implemented within 12 months of the energy assessment. Financing available through the St. Paul Port Authority Trillion BTU program makes these energy savings even more attractive.
